

HOME PAGE: SURFING THROUGH THE TIME ZONES

To facilitate the 'how to' part of the question-asking process, we've broken the act of questioning into three basic time zones:



a question is asked.

There's also the

INTERFACE BETWEEN ZONE

and the not-so-basic

SELDOM (IF EVER)- ZONE.

Becoming aware of the various time zones will help you understand what the question-asking process is all about.

HOT TIP

*Try some Mental Bungee JUMPING
between the various Zones.*

*Becoming familiar with the unique aspects of each time zone
puts you on the road to Asking SMART Questions.*

THE ZONES

Time in the question zones is non-linear—everything sort of happens at once. That's fine when you're used to it. Until then, you'll need to do one thing at a time. Begin at the beginning—enter the Q' Queue (the Question Queue) in the Before-Zone and find out some basic information about question asking. An important element of Useful Question asking lurks at the Interface Between the BEFORE-ZONE and the DURING-ZONE.
